AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO GIVE EVENING COURSES IN MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVING EDUCATION TO PERSONS UNDER TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13D of chapter 71 of the General Laws, in-
2 serted by chapter 205 of the acts of 1948, is hereby
3 amended by adding to the end thereof the following:—
4 Also, evening courses in motor vehicle driving edu-
5 cation, as prescribed by the registrar of motor vehicles,
6 may be given in the schools of any town for the train-
7 ing of persons under twenty-five years of age regard-
8 less of whether such persons are licensed or unlicensed
9 by the registrar. In their discretion, school com-
10 mittees may fix reasonable fees for tuition.
