AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DIGGING OF WORMS AND CLAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no re-
2 strictions of any nature shall be placed, or any penal-
3 ties invoked, upon any person digging worms and
4 clams within the boundaries of the commonwealth
5 save that such person shall be a resident thereof.
