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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REFERENDUM IN PLAN E CITIES  
ON THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING FOR THE NOMINATIONS  
FOR CERTAIN OFFICERS THEREIN BY PRELIMINARY  
ELECTION, AND THEIR ELECTION BY ORDINARY PLU-  
RALITY VOTING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Section 3 of chapter 661 of the acts of 1949, as most  
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 118 of the  
3 acts of 1953, is hereby further amended by striking  
4 out, in line 2, the word "five" and inserting in place  
5 thereof the word: — ten.
