AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF LAND AND THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES OF RECREATION AREAS IN THE VICINITY OF LAKE QUINSIGAMOND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of natural resources is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to construct recreation areas in
3 the vicinity of or contiguous to Lake Quinsigamond
4 upon such lands and with such structures and facili-
5 ties for recreation as may be necessary to provide
6 suitable and adequate recreation areas. The commis-
7 sion is authorized and directed to acquire such land
8 as is necessary by purchase, eminent domain or other-
9 wise. For the foregoing purposes the said commission
10 may expend such sums as may be appropriated
11 therefor.

The House of Representatives and the Senate shall have the honor to receive the report of the Commission on the Administration of the Government, which is herewith transmitted to the Senate and the House of Representatives.
