### AN ACT TO INDEMNIFY TEACHERS FOR CERTAIN EXPENSES OR DAMAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws, as amended, is  
2 hereby further amended by inserting a new section  
3 100B to read as follows:—

4 *Section 100B.* A city or town shall indemnify a  
5 teacher or member of the school department to an  
6 amount not more than the amount recommended by  
7 the school committee of the city or town for expenses  
8 or damages incurred by him in the defence or settle-  
9 ment of an action brought against him for acts done  
10 by him while acting as a teacher.
