By Mr. Key of Winthrop, petition of William E. Pierce and others (selectmen) that the Department of Public Works be authorized to construct shore protection on the easterly shore of the town of Winthrop. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PROTECTION OF THE EASTERLY SHORE OF THE TOWN OF WINTHROP WHICH RUNS PARALLEL TO TAFT AVENUE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authori-
2 zed and directed to increase the height of the sea wall
3 which runs from a point near the easterly end of
4 Otis street toward Deer Island by three feet. For
5 said purpose said department may expend, subject
6 to appropriation, the sum of dollars, to-
7 gether with the sum of dollars to be pro-
8 vided by the town of Winthrop. No work shall be
9 begun until said town has assumed liability in the
10 manner provided by section twenty-nine of chapter
11 ninety-one of the General Laws for all damages that
12 may be incurred thereunder, and shall have deposited
13 in the state treasury the sum of dollars for
14 the purpose herein set forth.

The Committee on the Judiciary, to which the bill was referred, has the honor to report the same with amendments, and to recommend its passage by the House.
