AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PROTECTION OF THE SHORE OF THE TOWN OF WINTHROP BETWEEN OTIS STREET AND DEER ISLAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to reconstruct the existing sea wall
3 at Point Shirley and/or such new sea walls as are
4 necessary along the ocean front at Point Shirley.
5 For said purpose said department may expend, sub-
6 ject to appropriation, the sum of dollars,
7 together with the sum of dollars to be
8 provided by the town of Winthrop. No work shall
9 be begun until said town has assumed liability in the
10 manner provided by section twenty-nine of chapter
11 ninety-one of the General Laws for all damages that
12 may be incurred thereunder, and shall have deposited
13 in the state treasury the sum of dollars
14 for the purpose herein set forth.
