AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT CERTAIN ROADS IN THE GREYLOCK RESERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subject to the conditions herein imposed the de-
2 partment of public works is hereby authorized and
3 directed to expend from the Highway Fund the sum
4 of fifty thousand dollars for the purpose of installing
5 a permanent hard surface on such roads in the Grey-
6 lock reservation as the Greylock reservation commis-
7 sion and the said department may select. No work
8 shall be begun until the county of Berkshire shall have
9 paid into the treasury of the commonwealth the sum
10 of fifty thousand dollars which sum, together with the
11 sum hereinbefore authorized to be expended from the
12 Highway Fund, shall constitute a fund for the im-
13 provement herein authorized, notwithstanding any
14 other provision of law to the contrary; provided, the
15 cost of said improvement shall not exceed ten thou-
16 sand dollars; and provided, further, that if any of
17 the last-mentioned sum remains after the completion
18 of said improvement, one half of such remainder shall
19 be repaid to said county.
