AN ACT RELATING TO THE LIMITATION OF ACTIONS ARISING OUT OF MOTOR VEHICLE HIT AND RUN ACCIDENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*
