### AN ACT RELATIVE TO REFUSALS OF APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 67 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended by section 18 of chapter 542 of the acts of  
3 1943, is hereby amended by adding at the end of  
4 said section 18 the following:—, and any applicant  
5 for a license who has twice been refused the granting  
6 of said license on the same premises by the local li-  
7 censing authorities, which action has subsequently  
8 been upheld by the alcoholic beverage control commis-  
9 sion, shall be prohibited from applying for a license  
10 on the same premises for a period of two years from  
11 the date of the second refusal.
