AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Any county, city or town that accepted chapter eight  
2 hundred and twenty of the acts of nineteen hundred  
3 and fifty, and did not increase those retired with less  
4 than fifteen years of creditable service, who were re-  
5 tired on account of injuries received or hazards under-  
6 gone in the performance of his duties, shall upon the  
7 passage of this act receive the increase granted under  
8 section one of said chapter eight hundred and twenty.
