AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF STATE EMPLOYEES HAVING THE CARE AND CUSTODY OF PRISONERS OR INSANE PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Employees of the institutions of the
2 state department of correction, whose regular and
3 major duties require them to have care and custody
4 of prisoners or of insane persons or of defective delin-
5 quents at the state farm, shall be advanced five salary
6 grades in the general salary schedule.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
