The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT REGULATING LEAVE WITH PAY TO PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES WITHIN THE STATE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 On and after the effective date of this act, depart-
2 ment heads, with the approval of the commissioner of
3 the commission on administration and finance, shall
4 authorize leave of absence with pay not to exceed ten
5 days per calendar year, to any person employed by
6 the commonwealth, if he makes application therefor,
7 to permit him to attend professional conferences per-
8 tinent to the best interests of the commonwealth.
