AN ACT AMENDING AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO CHARLES H. MCSWEENEY OF BELMONT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 213 of the acts of 1952 is
2 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4 and 5,
3 the words "reimburse him for medical and dental ex-
4 penses incurred by him as a result of an accident"
5 and inserting in place thereof the words: — compen-
6 sate him for injuries, — so as to read as follows: —
7 For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the
8 county commissioners of Middlesex county are hereby
9 authorized to pay to Charles H. McSweeney of Bel-
10 mont the sum of five hundred dollars to compensate
11 him for injuries sustained in the probate court of said
12 county on May seventeenth, nineteen hundred and
13 fifty-one. No payment shall be made hereunder until
14 there shall have been filed with the treasurer of said
15 county an agreement signed by said Charles H.
16 McSweeney that the amount, if any, paid or to be
17 paid for legal services rendered in connection with
18 the passage of this act shall not exceed ten per cent
19 of the sum paid hereunder.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by the county
3 commissioners of Middlesex county, but not other-
4 wise.
