AN ACT GRANTING CERTAIN PENSION RIGHTS TO WIDOWS OF FIREMEN AND POLICEMEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary widows of
- 2 firemen and policemen while they remain unmarried
- 3 shall receive the same pension or retirement benefits
- 4 as those to which their husbands would have been
- 5 entitled at the time of their retirement or were re-
- 6 ceiving at the time of their death.

THE COMPANIES ACT 1900

Section 104. Power to alter articles of association.
