AN ACT EXEMPTING CHURCHES FROM PAYMENT OF FEES
FOR LICENSES FOR USE OF PROPERTY UNDER THEIR
OWNERSHIP OR JURISDICTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 34 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by section 4 of chapter 541 of the acts of
3 1952, is hereby further amended by adding at the end
4 thereof the following sentence:— This section shall
5 not apply to any duly established church located in
6 any city or town in connection with the use of a hall
7 owned by it or under its jurisdiction when such use is
8 for religious or charitable purposes.
