AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OBSERVANCE OF ARMISTICE DAY CELEBRATED ON NOVEMBER ELEVENTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, clause
2 Eighteen, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 words "said days" in line 6 thereof, the following
4 words:— and on November eleventh all stores and
5 factories and other business establishments of all
6 kinds shall be closed all day except those engaged in
7 defense work.
