- 4 thereof the words: one mile, so that the fol-
- 5 lowing clause will read as follows: (a) That no 6 transportation reimbursement shall be made on ac-
- 7 count of any pupil who resides less than one mile
- 8 from the school which he attends, measured by a
- 9 commonly travelled route.
