AN ACT PROVIDING FOR OVERTIME PAY FOR WORK IN  
EXCESS OF FORTY HOURS PER WEEK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 151, as most recently amended, is hereby

3 tion 3A in said chapter 151 of the General Laws:—  
4 *Section 3A.* No employer shall employ any em-  
5 ployee for more than forty hours per week, unless such  
6 employee receives compensation for his employment  
7 in excess of forty hours at a rate not less than one and  
8 one half times the regular hourly rate of pay at which  
9 he is employed.
