## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE SIGNATURE OF THE WIFE OF A  
BORROWER UNDER THE STATUTE REGULATING LOANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws, as amended, is  
2 hereby further amended by inserting after section 92  
3 the following new section:—

4 *Section 92A.* No person, agency or corporation  
5 authorized to make loans shall advance any money to  
6 a borrower unless the application for same, if said  
7 borrower is married, is signed by his wife.
