AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITH CRACKED, BROKEN, OR FOGGY WINDSHIELDS OR REAR WINDOWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after section 9A the following:—
- 3 *Section 9B.* No person shall operate any motor
- 4 vehicle having a cracked, broken or foggy windshield
- 5 or rear window. The registrar shall, after allowing a
- 6 reasonable period for replacement of a defective wind-
- 7 shield or rear window, revoke the registration of any
- 8 motor vehicle having the same.
