### AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE TERM "VETERAN".

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended, is hereby further amended by inserting  
3 after clause 6 the following clause:—

4 6A. The period since June twenty-fifth, nineteen  
5 hundred and fifty, during the hostilities between the  
6 armed forces of the United States and United Na-  
7 tions against communist China, and whether under  
8 the flag of the United States or of the United Nations.
