AN ACT DEFINING THE PHRASE "IN TIME OF WAR" AS USED IN THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (1) of section 21 of chapter 31 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter
3 663 of the acts of 1951, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting after the word "insurrection" in line 3 the
5 words: — , or during the Korean emergency between
6 June twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and fifty, and
7 the termination of the emergency as declared by
8 proper federal authority.
