AN ACT RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS BY CITIES AND TOWNS FOR CELEBRATING CERTAIN DAYS OR OCCASIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause (27) of section 5 of chapter 40 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended by section 8 of chapter 358 of the  
3 acts of 1946, is hereby further amended by inserting  
4 after the word "July" in line 1 of said section 8 the  
5 following: — for the celebration of Labor Day.
