MEMORANDUM OF COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION PURSUANT TO GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 7, WITH RESPECT TO PETITION OF REPRESENTATIVE ANTHONY FOR LEGISLATION AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF A FUND FOR THE SUPPORT OF A CONGREGATIONAL MINISTER IN THE FIRST PARISH IN BRADFORD TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF A FUND FOR THE SUPPORT OF A CONGREGATIONAL MINISTER IN THE FIRST PARISH IN BRADFORD TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of an act passed by the general court of
2 Massachusetts February 10, 1804, entitled "An Act
3 to Incorporate Certain Persons as Trustees of a Fund
4 for the Support of a Congregational Gospel Minister
5 in the First Parish in Bradford, in the County of
6 Essex", as amended by chapter 77 of the acts of
7 1909, is hereby further amended by striking out, in
8 line 16, the word "fifty" and inserting in place
9 thereof the words: — one hundred.
