AN ACT RELATING TO THE CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE CONCORD AND SUDBURY RIVERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby au-
2 thorized to construct and carry out the works neces-
3 sary for the control and improvement of the Sudbury
4 and Concord rivers as set forth in paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4
5 and 5 on pages thirty-three, thirty-four and thirty-
6 five of House bill number two thousand four hundred
7 and fifteen of nineteen hundred and fifty-one, special
8 report of the department of public works, including
9 excavation of the Fordway Bar, reconstruction of the
10 dam at the Talbot Mills, and river improvement in
11 Lowell, Concord and above Concord, and to expend
12 therefor such sums as may hereafter be appropriated
13 for the purpose.
