### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE LABOR STATUTES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 79 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as

3 amended by inserting after the word "inspector",  
4 in line 4 and line 5, in each instance, the words:—
