RESOLVE FURTHER INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO RENTS TO BE PAID BY CERTAIN VETERANS IN STATE HOUSING UNITS.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission estab-
2 lished by chapter eighty-four of the resolves of nine-
3 teen hundred and fifty-three to make an investigation
4 and study relative to rents to be paid by certain
5 veterans in state housing units, shall, in making its
6 investigation and study, consider the subject matter
7 of current senate document numbered 149, relative
8 to providing for the exclusion of disability compensa-
9 tion in computing rent as well as net income for
10 veterans in state-aided housing projects.
