RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO INVESTIGATE AND STUDY THE CONDITIONS AT PENAL INSTITUTIONS WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established  
2 by chapter fifty-four of the resolves of nineteen hun-  
3 dred and fifty-three for the purpose of making an  
4 investigation and study of the conditions at penal in-  
5 stitutions within the commonwealth shall, in making  
6 its investigation and study, consider the subject matter  
7 of current house document numbered 1099, relative  
8 to prohibiting the parole of persons convicted of kid-  
9 napping.
