AN ACT TO PLACE THE POSITION OF SCHOOLHOUSE CUSTODIAN UNDER CIVIL SERVICE IN THE CITY OF BOSTON SCHOOL DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 31 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 26 of the
3 acts of 1951, is hereby further amended by striking
4 out, in line 22, the words “; the schoolhouse custodian
5 of the city of Boston”.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall in no way effect the
2 status of the present incumbent of the position of
3 schoolhouse custodian in the school department of the
4 city of Boston.
