AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO MAKE REPAIRS AND ALTERATIONS TO THE SHAKER MILL DAM ON THE WILLIAMS RIVER IN THE TOWN OF WEST STOCKBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make such repairs
3 and alterations and such other improvements as are
4 necessary or advisable to the so-called Shaker Mill
5 dam in the town of West Stockbridge. Said work is
6 to be done for the purpose of increasing the spillway
7 capacity of the dam.

1 SECTION 2. No work shall be done hereunder
2 until the town of West Stockbridge shall have assumed
3 liability in the manner provided by section twenty-
4 nine of chapter ninety-one of the General Laws for
5 all damages that may be incurred under the project.

1 SECTION 3. For the purposes of this act there
2 may be expended such sums as are now available or
3 may hereafter be appropriated therefor.
