RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY TO BE MADE BY THE FISCAL SURVEY COM- MISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission estab-
2 lished by chapter twenty of the resolves of the current
3 year for the purpose of investigating and studying
4 certain fiscal practices and policies of the common-
5 wealth, in the course of its investigation and study,
6 shall consider the subject matter of current senate
7 document numbered 121, relative to the payment of
8 bonds issued by the commonwealth; current senate
9 document numbered 568, relative to the allocation
10 of certain balances in the Highway Fund; current
11 senate document numbered 571, relative to reallo-
12 cation of positions and increases of salaries or com-
13 pensation provided for in supplementary appropria-
14 tions; and current senate document numbered 580,
15 limiting the transfer and use of the veterans' services
16 fund; current house document numbered 344, relative
17 to the state purposes tax revenue fund; and current
18 house document numbered 719, creating the local
19 assistance tax revenue fund.
