AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE LAWS RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 113H, inserted by section 5
3 of chapter 570 of the acts of 1953, the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 113I.* The commissioner shall fix and es-
6 tablish a schedule of fair and reasonable service
7 charges, together with enabling rules and regulations,
8 in connection with the securing or placing of motor
9 vehicle liability insurance under the plan of appor-
10 tionment provided for under the provisions of section
11 one hundred and thirteen H. Whenever any person
12 duly licensed under any provision of this chapter fails
13 to comply with such promulgations, the commissioner,
14 for cause shown and after a hearing, shall suspend his
15 license for such period of time as he in his discretion
16 deems feasible.
