Ordered, That the house committee on Ways and Means be authorized to sit during the recess of the general court to study the subject matter of current house document numbered 2412, the special report of the department of public works relative to Fort Point Channel and certain territories adjacent thereto and to certain proposed waterways projects. Said committee shall report to the general court the results of its study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives not later than the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
