*Ordered,* That the Commission on Administration and Finance is hereby authorized to make an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house document numbered 297, relative to authorizing so-called whole-dollar bookkeeping in those fiscal activities of the state government where its use is approved by the Commissioner of Administration. Said commission shall hold hearings, and may expend for clerical and other expenses such sum as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
