AN ACT PERMITTING JAMES PAUL DALLAS TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE STATE-BOSTON RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any provision of chapter three hundred and seventy-
2 nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-two
3 to the contrary notwithstanding, James Paul Dallas,
4 shall, upon paying into the annuity fund of the State-
5 Boston retirement system, in one sum, or in install-
6 ments upon such terms and conditions as the Boston
7 retirement board may prescribe, make-up payments
8 of a sum equal to the difference between the con-
9 tributions he has made to the Boston retirement
10 fund since January first, nineteen hundred and forty-
11 seven, and the contributions he would have made if
12 he had joined the State-Boston retirement fund on
13 that date, together with regular interest thereon,
14 become a member of the said State-Boston Retire-
15 ment system. Upon the completion of such make-up
16 payments he shall be entitled to all creditable service
17 to which he would have been entitled had he joined
18 the State-Boston retirement system when first eligible
19 to become a member.
