RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO INVESTIGATE AND STUDY CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE INSURANCE LAWS AND MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established by
2 chapter seventy-seven of the resolves of nineteen
3 hundred and fifty-three for the purpose of making an
4 investigation and study relative to the insurance laws
5 of the commonwealth, in making its investigation and
6 study, shall consider the subject matter of current
7 house document numbered 1223, relative to providing
8 for payment of workmen's compensation and for suit
9 against a negligent third party without necessity of
10 election.
