AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NON-CRIMINAL DISPOSITION OF
PARKING VIOLATIONS WITH RESPECT TO PARKING AREAS
ADJACENT TO OR ABUTTING COUNTY BUILDINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 20A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 249 of
3 the acts of 1953, is hereby further amended by adding
4 at the end the following paragraph: —

5 The provisions of this section shall apply to viola-
6 tions of rules and regulations relative to the use of
7 parking areas adjacent to or abutting county buildings,
8 and county commissioners are hereby authorized to
9 make said rules and regulations.
