AND STUDY TO BE MADE BY THE FISCAL SURVEY COM-
MISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission es-

3 current year for the purpose of investigating and
4 studying certain fiscal practices and policies of the
5 commonwealth, in the course of its investigation and
6 study, shall consider the subject matter of current
7 house document numbered 2335, Appendix A, relative

9 parks and other lands of the commonwealth, and
10 current house document numbered 2335, Appendix B,
11 relating to improved facilities and co-ordinated effort
