## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO REBUILD THE PRISON POINT BRIDGE AND TO ACQUIRE LAND FOR WIDENING PURPOSES IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to rebuild and reconstruct  
3 the prison point bridge in the cities of Cambridge  
4 and Boston.

5 The department of correction is hereby authorized  
6 and directed to transfer to the metropolitan district  
7 commission the care and control of so much of the  
8 land now occupied by the state prison as may be  
9 necessary for the purposes of this act.

10 For the purposes of this act, the commission is  
11 hereby authorized to expend such sums as may be  
12 appropriated therefor.
