## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT TO TRANSFER AN EMPLOYEE TO THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC BEACHES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Robert J. Brault, who held the posi-  
2 tion of conservation helper at the Salisbury Beach  
3 reservation in the department of conservation for a  
4 period of five years prior to the transfer of the func-  
5 tions of such position to the division of public beaches,  
6 is hereby permanently transferred to a similar posi-  
7 tion in the division of public beaches, without loss of  
8 retirement or other rights.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
