### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF A BRIDGE OVER THE CONNECTICUT RIVER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The bridge across the Connecticut river from a  
2 point in the Turners Falls section of the town of  
3 Montague to a point on the state highway in the vicinity  
4 of the Riverside section of the town of Gill shall, on  
5 and after July first, nineteen hundred and fifty-four,  
6 be maintained as a public highway by the department  
7 of public works. The county shall initiate the transfer  
8 and provide all records and plans of said bridge to the  
9 department of public works. Upon the effective date  
10 of this act the said bridge shall be a state highway  
11 with approach limits to be established by the depart-  
12 ment of public works.
