## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO APPROPRIATE AND PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO FRANCIS D. GARVEY TO REIMBURSE HIM FOR CERTAIN INJURIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral  
2 obligation, the city of Boston is hereby authorized to  
3 appropriate and pay to Francis D. Garvey of Chelsea,  
4 to indemnify him for medical and surgical expenses  
5 not covered by insurance incurred as a result of in-  
6 juries sustained at South Boston Stadium while  
7 officiating at a football game sponsored by the park  
8 department recreational division of the city of Boston,  
9 such sums of money not in excess of one hundred  
10 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city  
3 subject to the provisions of its charter.
