AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS TO REINSTATE WILLIAM K. JOHNSON FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the
2 public good and notwithstanding the provisions of any
3 other law, the state board of retirement may reinstate
4 William K. Johnson as a member of the state retire-
5 ment system for the purpose of retirement only, and
6 said William K. Johnson shall be retired in accordance
7 with the provisions of section seven of chapter thirty-
8 two of the General Laws; provided, that the amount
9 of his pension shall be based on his compensation at the
10 time of his original retirement.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
