AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 3 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of
3 chapter 803 of the acts of 1951, is hereby further
4 amended by inserting after the word "leaders" in
5 line 6 the words: — and whips.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January
2 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
