AN ACT RELATIVE TO COUNTY BEACHES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 61 of chapter 16 of the General Laws, as
- 2 amended by chapter 666 of the acts of 1953, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding at the end thereof the
- 4 following sentence:— This section shall not apply to
- 5 any area now or hereafter under the management or
- 6 control of any county or county commissioners.
