AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN THE CITY OF BOSTON MAY BE USED FOR PURPOSES OF A CONSULATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of section twenty-three
2 of chapter one hundred and eighty-four of the Gen-
3 eral Laws, or any corresponding provision of earlier
4 laws, relating to conditions or restrictions by which
5 the title or use of real property is affected, shall not
6 apply to the land and building located at number one
7 hundred and seven Beacon street, in the city of Boston,
8 and said land and building may be used for the usual
9 purposes of a consulate.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
