AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO ESTABLISH A BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS EXERCISING THE POWERS OF CERTAIN OTHER DEPARTMENTS AND OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There shall be established in the city
2 of Malden a board of public works, hereinafter called
3 the board, to consist of five members who shall be
4 appointed by the mayor with the approval of the
5 council, to serve for such terms and at such salaries as
6 the mayor and city council shall determine.

1 SECTION 2. Upon the qualification of the initial
2 members of the board, the board shall have all the
3 powers, rights and duties now or from time to time
4 vested by general or special law in the public works
5 department, sewer department, water department,
6 park department and forestry department and such
7 departments shall thereupon be abolished during such
8 time as this act is in force.
