RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO AUTHORIZE THE FEDERAL HOUSING ADMINISTRATION TO TAKE CERTAIN STEPS IN COMBATTING JUVENILE DELINQUENCY IN HOUSING PROJECT AREAS.

Whereas, The shameful record of juvenile delinquency presents a problem that must be faced and settled, and it is imperative that immediate action be taken to counteract the rising juvenile delinquency throughout the commonwealth and the nation; and

Whereas, Better police protection in crowded tenement areas is necessary, and wider recreational projects are needed to occupy the time and the minds of our teenagers; therefore be it

Resolved, That the general court of Massachusetts urges the Congress of the United States to take immediate action in authorizing the Federal Housing Administration to permit local housing authorities to hire special police officers to patrol housing projects during the night hours; and be it further

Resolved, That the Congress of the United States make additional funds available for the hiring of personnel to develop sport and recreation programs in housing projects; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be transmitted forthwith by the secretary of the commonwealth to the President of the United States, to the presiding officer of each branch of the Congress and to each member of the Congress from this commonwealth.
