To accompany the petition of Otis M. Whitney for legislation to establish a penalty for making, altering or repairing any oil burning installation without first obtaining a certificate of competency. Public Safety.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR MAKING, ALTERING OR REPAIRING ANY OIL BURNING INSTALLATION WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 148 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding after section 10A a new section, which reads
3 as follows: —

4 *Section B.* Any person who makes, alters or re-
5 pairs any oil burning installation without having first
6 obtained a certificate of competency from the marshal,
7 or any person who makes, alters or repairs any oil
8 burning installation after his certificate of competency
9 has been suspended or revoked by the marshal, shall
10 be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five and
11 not more than one hundred dollars.

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to provide for the better regulation of the business of the State of Michigan, and to provide for the better protection of the public interest in the business of the State of Michigan.
